Quassy Amusement Park to open new roller coaster, swing ride in '25



Quassy Amusement Park and Waterpark is introducing two new rides for its 2025 season: a spinning family roller coaster and a swing ride.

Quassy Amusement Park and Waterpark is introducing two new rides for its 2025 season.

A new "spinning family roller coaster" will have a "figure-eight track design" and feature spinning carts, according to a news release. A name for the new roller coaster has not been revealed.

The second attraction that will open in 2025 is "Aladdin Wave Swinger," a swing ride inspired by the movie "Aladdin." The wood panels that will adorn the ride will be made by Wooddesign Amusement Rides, a Netherlands-based manufacturing and restoring company that specializes in carousels and swing rides.

"It's one thing to be able to introduce a new ride, but having the opportunity to showcase two new rides in one season is rare," said Eric Anderson, president of Quassy, in a news release. "We're so excited for our guests to experience the thrilling adventure that awaits them in 2025."

In order to make way for the Aladdin Wave Swinger, Quassy announced that the Yo-Yo swing ride, which debuted in the park in 2004, would be retired ahead of the 2025 season.

Though the park is closed for the 2024 season, season passes for 2025 are currently for sale for \$105.99 for park access and \$35 for parking. Season pass renewals are the same price.
